The funds from the mission appeal will be used to renovate a residential home for the needy blind and aged people that was constructed by Father Sserugga's home diocese in 1975. Currently this residential home accommodates 150 people. The total amount needed for the renovation is \$250,000. 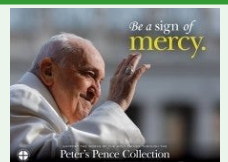

St. Raphael Counseling is part of Catholic Charities and the Archdiocese of Denver and now has an office in Eagle.

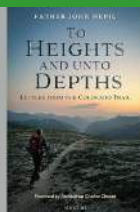
