


MISSION STATEMENT

Fredrick Sserugga will be making a mission appeal for his home diocese, the Archdiocese of Kampala in Uganda, at the Vail Chapel on Saturday July 19th, at St. Patrick Church and at the Vail Chapel on Sunday July 20th. On Saturday July 26th he will be at the Beaver Creek Chapel and on Sunday July 27th at the Beaver Creek Chapel and St. Clare of Assisi Church. The funds from the mission appeal will be used to renovate a residential home for the needy blind and aged people that was constructed by Father Sserugga's home diocese in 1975. Currently this residential home accommodates 150 people. The total amount needed for the renovation is \$250,000. 


