

We are moving forward toward construction of our new churches, but we are at a critical decision point. To remain within the \$13 million construction budget for each church, design reductions are already being made. What we raise now determines what we are able to build.

### Where We Stand

- Each church has a \$13 million construction budget.
- We are raising the final \$1 million for each church.
- St. Mary's and St. Clare must each raise its final \$1 million.
- Without additional funds, key elements must be reduced or deferred in the next 30 days.
- If we are able to exceed the \$1 million goal at each church, planned cuts can be avoided and they can be built as envisioned.
