Lenten Regulations

As Jesus fasted 40 days in the desert, the Church fasts during Lent. Fasting is symbolic of a change of heart as we turn away from sin and live in fidelity to the Gospel.

FASTING: Ages 18-59 fast on **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** limiting themselves to one full meal and two smaller meals each day. No snacking between meals

ABSTINENCE. Catholics age 14 and older abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.

As you may know, a Take Out Meal is offered at the Methodist Church every Monday and St. Mary's Volunteers cook and serve the meal the second Monday of each Month. 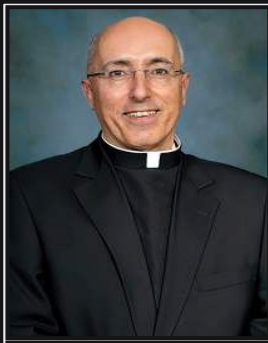

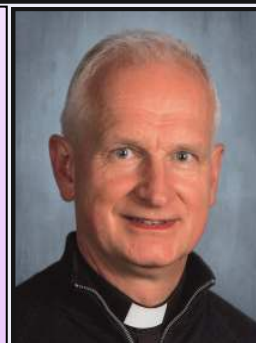

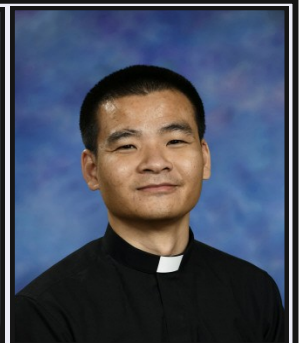
